The Solution

Based on her research, Morgan determined that X-Rite was the most reliable choice. She opted for a Ci64 handheld spectrophotometer and Color iMatch formulation software to both develop her own library of colors and to formulate the colors her customers specified. She also added a ColorMunki Design for profiling and calibrating her monitor and printer.

Results

In July 2016, Morgan launched her brand Inkk at **www.yourinkk.com**, enabling a customer to use a color spectrum, upload a preexisting photo or use her Android or iOS app to take photos as the basis for creating custom nail polish colors. In most cases, Color iMatch allows her to formulate an accurate color recipe with only minor adjustments.

With her X-Rite solution in place, Morgan can create custom nail polish colors in quantities as small as one bottle in a few minutes, often shipping product same day.
