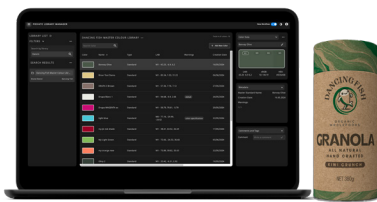

Ensure Everyone is Aiming for the Same Color Target

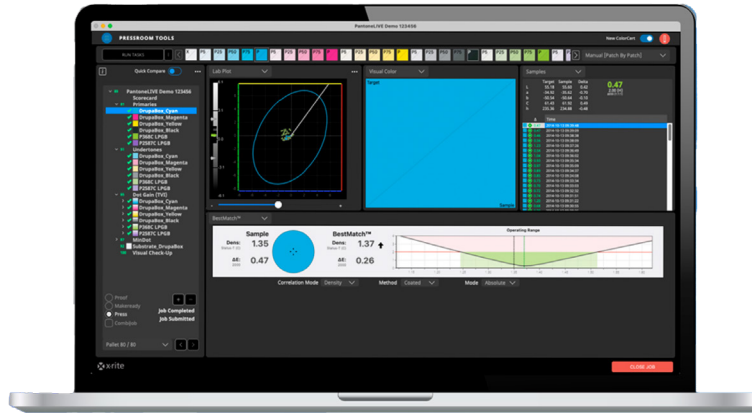

- Private Library colors can be used in PantoneLIVE Production for Print and Packaging and PantoneLIVE Production for Plastic, Coating & Textile.
- Private Library Manager colors seamlessly integrate in X-Rite's suite of color solutions, including ColorCert, Color iQC, Color iMatch, Atura Ink, InkFormulation Software, and more.
- Pantone and private colors hosted in the PantoneLIVE cloud are locked and cannot be modified, and only approved individuals can access them.
- PantoneLIVE Private Library Manager is a cloud-based architecture with a web interface and does not require software installation.
- When a private color is uploaded to PantoneLIVE Private Library Manager, it includes a metadata tag with information about how the color was measured, including:
 - Device geometry
 - Color owner
 - Substrate
 - Approval cycle
 - Date of publication
- PantoneLIVE is integrated with more than twenty 20 third party software solutions and digital print controllers. Authorized users of a private library can also use the colors in connected third party products.
- Users of X-Rite ColorCert can measure private colors and upload them to a PantoneLIVE Private Color Library to ensure the definition of the color in Color Exchange (CxF) format is completely in conformance with the rigorous definition of CxF required in the PantoneLIVE database.
